Step 02: Complete the login credentials

- If you do not have an existing MyImpactPage.com account with Dementia Australia or any other organisation, enter your desired username and email address in the "I am new to MyImpactPage.com" section. Then, click "Save and Continue" to open the application form.
- If you already have an account, fill in your username and password under “I already have a username” section and click “Log in and Continue”. Then continue to Step 04.

Your username must be at least 6 characters long. Step 03: Complete the Contact Information.

If you logged in during Step 02 (by clicking “Log in and Continue” in the “I already have a username” section), you can skip this step and proceed directly to Step 04.

If you are a new user and clicked “Save and Continue” in Step 02 (from the “I am new to MyImpactPage.com” section), the contact information form will now be displayed.

- When filling out the form, please ensure you fill in all the fields marked as required (flag symbol). Note: Some fields may be pre-filled based on the information provided in the previous step. You can leave these as they are.
- Once you have completed the form, click "Save and Continue" to create your MyImpactPage account and proceed to the Dementia Friend application.
- If you have missed any mandatory fields, you will receive an error message indicating which fields need to be completed.
- If this step is successful, you have created a MyImpactPage account.

Step 04: Complete the Dementia Friend application

After completing the questions, click "Submit Application" on the bottom right of the screen.

If you successfully submitted your application, you will receive a confirmation email at the address provided during registration.
